



HOW TO GET TO THE HERITAGE FESTIVAL AT PARRAMATTA NORTH

CAR

Parramatta North Heritage Core is a 30 – 45 min drive from the Sydney CBD. There's a variety of [car parks](#) around the Parramatta CBD including Wilson Parking, Secure Parking and Council car parks.

Please note: No parking will be available on the day at 1 Fleet Street, North Parramatta. Disabled parking will be available at Parramatta Leagues Club.

TRAIN

Scheduled track works on the weekend will affect Parramatta Station.

- Buses replace trains between St Marys and Granville, and between Richmond and Granville.
- Trains run to a changed timetable between Penrith and St Marys, and between Granville and Central, platforms 1-12.

Walk approx. 20-25 mins from the train station to the Festival.

CYCLING

Valet bike parking on site.

FREE SHUTTLE BUS

Leaves Macquarie Street near Centenary Square, every 10 mins between 8.00am and 4.00pm. Get off at the Parramatta Leagues Club on O'Connell Street and walk to the Festival.
